Be on the forefront of mediating the focus of dispute resolution: helping elders and their families work together to make effective decisions as they progress through the difficult decisions that impact their quality of life, including driving privileges, staying in the home, financial and health concerns. **As a civil and/or family mediator**, you will benefit by expanding your mediator skills and by considering the ethical decisions you need to make as an eldercare mediator. **Non-mediators in the field of aging are encouraged to attend but should be advised the material assumes some experience in family dispute resolution.** Experienced mediator coaches will be present during the role-plays to help mediators improve their skills and professionalism. During role-plays, the training participants will serve as mediators or as family members.
